

Lector Rules

(Updated February 2017)

At Home

- Dress appropriately. No jeans, sneakers, or other casual wear.
- Studying your reading before you arrive.

Before Mass

- Check the bulletin board and sign in at least 15 minutes before Mass.
- Verify that the marked passage at the ambo matches what you studied.
- (Lector 2) Read over the Prayers of the Faithful in the green folder.

Mass

- 1. In the entrance procession, Lector 2 follows the altar servers.
- 2. Lector 1 follows Lector 2.
- 3. If no deacon serves, Lector 1 carries the Book of the Gospels, chin high, arms partially extended.
- 4. Lector 2 processes directly to his seat without stopping to bow.
- 5. If he has the Book of the Gospels, Lector 1 processes up the right-hand side of the altar, walks behind it, and places the Book of the Gospels in the stand. He then goes directly to his seat without bowing.
- 6. When it is time for the readings, Lector 1 reads the 1st reading, saying only what is printed on the page in front of him.
- 7. After the Responsorial Psalm, Lector 2 reads the 2nd reading, saying only what is printed on the page in front of him.
- 8. Lector 2 closes the Lectionary and carries it to the vessel table. He places it on the right hand side, squared with the table's edge.
- 9. Walk up to the Ambo just about toward the end of the Creed, if no deacon serves, Lector 2 leads the Prayer of the Faithful.
- 10. At the end of Mass, lectors line up side-by-side, facing the tabernacle, in front of the altar servers. Watch for Father to cue everyone to turn and process out.
