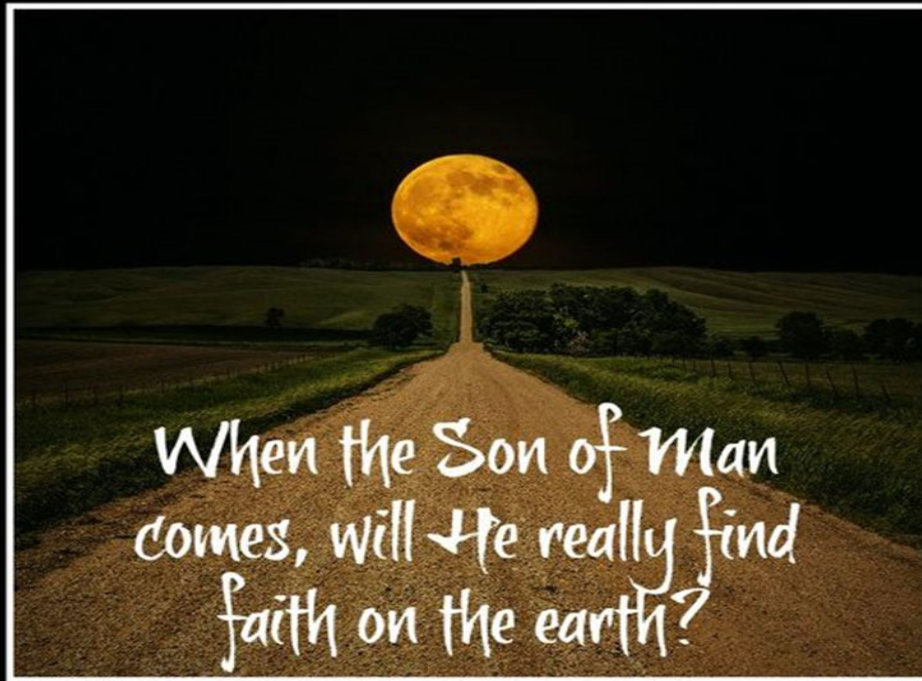

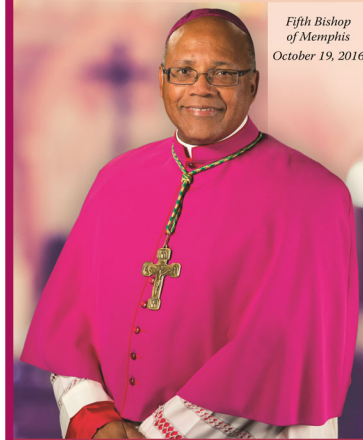

CHILDREN'S FAITH FORMATION

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES: PRE classes are for children 3yrs-8th grade, High School Sacramental Prep, and RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children). Contact the Parish Religious Education Dept. to sign up your child. Classes meet Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings.

DIOCESAN GUIDELINES: The Diocese of Memphis requires that all students preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Communion, and Confirmation, have two consecutive years of religious education prior to receiving the sacrament. Children in 1st & 7th grade need to be enrolled in a religious education program in order to make their sacraments in 2nd & 8th grades.

Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least of my brothers, you did it for me." Matthew 25: 40

The **Parish Social Ministry Office** organizes our parish efforts to do just that. Through Social Ministry, Incarnation parishioners serve:

1. **Each other** with meals, prayers, visits, cards, and comfort in times of illness, loss, and recovery.
 - Food Angels: Meals in bereavement, recovery, or emergency
 - Card Ministry, Friendly Visits, and Ministry to the Sick for those at home or in care facilities
 - Transportation to mass, grocery store, or doctor's offices
 - Special Needs activities
 - Loaning medical items (wheelchairs, crutches, etc.)
2. **The needy in our community** with direct service, works of justice and mercy, and social action.
 - Volunteer "Care Ministers" to receive guests in need of food or bills paid.
 - Food Pantry: Open Monday-Friday 10AM - 2PM
 - Project Outreach: Feeding the poor in Fayette County
 - Room at the Inn: Housing the homeless 1-2 times each winter month
 - Catholic Charities: Helping out with Diocesan projects for the needy.

Jubilee Year of Mercy

October 16, 2016

Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Though Jesus told today's parable more than two thousand years ago, human nature hasn't changed: we recognize both characters instantly. The merciless judge represents the corruption that has short-circuited justice throughout history; the distraught widow, society's perennially powerless, marginalized to what Pope Francis calls the "peripheries" by those who wield power but lack the mercy that could transfigure society with compassion. To confront such reality, Jesus bids us, "pray always without becoming weary" (Luke 18:1). Prayer opens our eyes to see others from Jesus' perspective, and leads us to work for justice by coming to the aid of others with what Pope Francis extols as a higher standard, *mercy*. Thus, when Jesus asks, "Will not God secure the rights of [God's] chosen ones? Will [God] be slow to answer?" (18:7). We respond by making God's liberating work for others our own. "[W]hen the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" (18:8). Yes, we respond—and mercy!

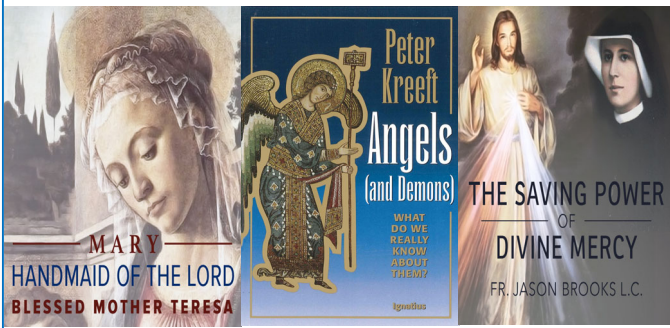

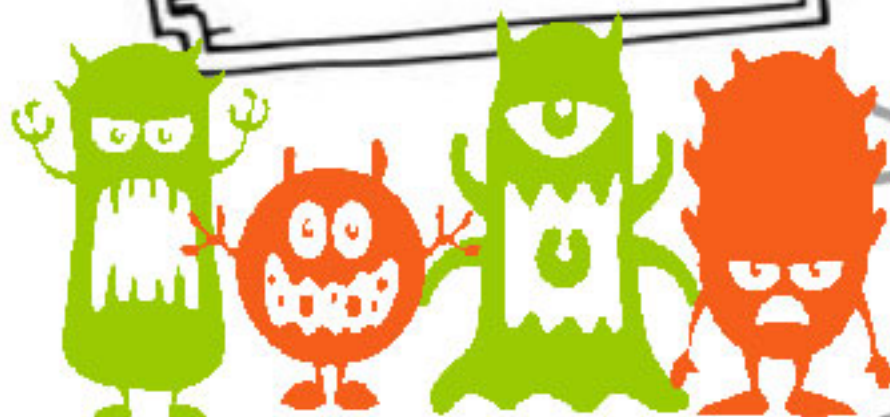
